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Requirements to earn the P.R.I.D.E. patch or strip: *Troop* or *individual* must perform a *minimum of two projects or activities*. By doing these activities you will enable the community to see the variety of beneficial activities available through Girl Scout involvement. Examples include the following:



- Perform a flag ceremony for the PTA, club meeting or a Memorial Day Service
- Singing at a nursing home
- Wider Opportunity participants speaking at civic clubs
- Babysitting for PTA meeting or elections
- Marching in local parade
- **Painting a mural in a children’s ward**
- Planting tree(s) or flowers in the park
- Painting park equipment
- Decorating Christmas tree(s) for shut-ins or nursing homes
- Entertaining at civic banquet

Troops or individual girls of all program levels may earn P.R.I.D.E. patch and/or strip yearly. The first year of P.R.I.D.E. recognition is the patch. Each year thereafter, the troop or youth will earn the P.R.I.D.E. strip. The requirements are the same for both the patch and the strip.

Order your P.R.I.D.E. Patch/Strip from the Girl Scouts Western Oklahoma Shop. The patch is \$1.25 and the strip is \$0.90. You must request a report and order form from the service center to buy the patches.
